Pastor's Word

The word for February is "Love".

You may feel this is a good word for February because of the 14th of February being Valentine's Day. However, the reason I have chosen the word "Love" is because we need a reminder of the love God has for us.

There are so many wonderful verses that tell us of God's love. Here are a few:

- Love is the essence of His character. We find this truth in the middle of 1 John 4:16 where we read "...God is love..."

 1 John 4:7-21 is a great study on love; God's love and the believers love (our love).
- God's love makes our salvation possible.
 - "But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." Romans 5:8 NIV
 "This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. " 1 John 4:10 NIV
 - "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him."

 John 3:16-17 NIV
- God's love is our security. In Christ, nothing can separate us from God's love (see Romans 8:28-39)
 "No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord." Romans 8:37-39 NIV
- God's love is our hope. In light of what we have and are going through these may be the verses we need to hold on to. "I will never forget this awful time, as I grieve over my loss. Yet I still dare to hope when I remember this: The faithful love of the LORD never ends! His mercies never cease. Great is His faithfulness; His mercies begin afresh each morning." Lamentations 3:20-23 NLT

These verses from Lamentations remind us of this truth: when things seem hopeless, you can hope in God because He loves you.
