Pastor's Word

What is the word for December? The word for December is JOY!

Webster defines joy as 1) "a feeling of great happiness" and 2) a source or cause of great happiness: something or someone that gives joy to someone.

The joy we celebrate at Christmas is found in the events surrounding the advent of Jesus.

We find joy in the angel's announcement to the shepherds keeping watch over their sheep in the fields outside of Bethlehem:

⁸ That night there were shepherds staying in the fields nearby, guarding their flocks of sheep. ⁹ Suddenly, an angel of the Lord appeared among them, and the radiance of the Lord's glory surrounded them. They were terrified, ¹⁰ but the angel reassured them. "Don't be afraid!" he said. "I bring you good news that will bring great joy to all people. ¹¹ The Savior—yes, the Messiah, the Lord—has been born today in Bethlehem, the city of David! ¹² And you will recognize him by this sign: You will find a baby wrapped snugly in strips of cloth, lying in a manger." ¹³ Suddenly, the angel was joined by a vast host of others—the armies of heaven—praising God and saying,

¹⁴ "Glory to God in highest heaven, and peace on earth to those with whom God is pleased."

Luke 2:8-14 NLT

The angel's announcement was an announcement of "good news" which brings with it "great joy." *The Savior—yes, the Messiah, the Lord—has been born today in Bethlehem, the city of David!*

If you Google search the meaning of "joy" you will find: "The biblical definition of joy says that joy is a feeling of good pleasure and happiness that is dependent on who Jesus is rather than on who we are or what is happening around us."

The promised and needed salvation has come and it is wrapped in the person of Jesus. Jesus is our salvation. Jesus is our joy! May you find the joy this Christmas, may you find Jesus!



For my article this month I would like to share this poem that I've seen over the last couple of years on FB.


