### **Pastor's Word**

The word for August is "Keep"

As a verb keep means to "have or retain possession of". There is so much that I would like to encourage you to "keep." I want to encourage you to retain possession of three lasting virtues:

- 1. Keep the faith, stay focused on Jesus every day. We often sing at the close of worship a song with that message; "Keep the faith someone really loves you. Keep the faith someone really cares. Keep the faith someone really loves you and that someone is the Lord." Jesus is the "author and perfecter" of our faith (Hebrews 12:1-2).
- 2. <u>Keep hope</u>. In the cover of my mom's Bible was written "You can trust an unknown future to a known God." Keeping hope reminds me of another song (Loretta's favorite), "Because He lives I can face tomorrow, because He lives all fear is gone, because I know He holds the future and life is worth the living just because He lives." We have hope because He is with us.
- 3. <u>Keep love</u>. Keep love burning in your heart for God, other believers, and the lost. Love is the first gift listed in the fruit of the Holy Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23). Jesus says it is the distinguishing trait of His disciples (John 13:34-35). In 1 Corinthians 13:7 we find the strength of love.
  - "Love never gives up, never loses faith, is always hopeful, and endures through every circumstance." 1 Corinthians 13:7

I would like to encourage you to keep faith, hope, and love a priority in your life. Everyday put them in action. I leave you with 1 Corinthians 13:13 NLT "Three things will last forever—faith, hope, and love—and the greatest of these is love."


