The word for January is "objective".

One of the meanings of the word "objective" found in Webster's New Collegiate Dictionary, which fits how I am using the word "objective" is "something toward which effort is directed: an aim or end of action."

As we begin a new year filled with new opportunities and challenges, I set two verses before us to serve as our guide in navigating 2021.

These two verses provide us with four objectives for 2021. Four objectives we will direct our effort toward. Four objectives we set our aim on intentionally putting forth effort to accomplish.

The first is the command found in Joshua 1:9 NIV "This is my command—be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid or discouraged. For the LORD your God is with you wherever you go."


